Provide basic life support, including patient assessment, airway management, use of automatic defibrillator and assist patients with medication. Provide pre-hospital emergency medical care of simple and multiple system trauma such as controlling hemorrhage, treatment of shock, bandaging wounds and immobilization of painful, swollen, deformed extremities.

Position will work under the direction of the Iron County Correctional Facility Medical Supervisor. This position will require working shifts to include **night**, **holiday and occasional call in**.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Maintains personal knowledge and skills in order to deliver optimum care as an EMT.
- Stocks and maintains medical equipment and supplies to ensure a state of readiness at all times.
- Works in hazardous environments to ensure safety and stabilization of patients.
- Works with contract pharmacist, contract physician, and contract psychologist to ensure a coordinated effort in care.
- Documents all patient care, assessments and responses in a timely fashion. Documentation shall be legible and accurate.
- When approved and/or required, participates in training.
- Complies with ICCF Code of Conduct at all times.
- Provide basic life support, including patient assessment, airway management, use of the automatic defibrillator and assist patients with medication.
- Be able to perform cardio-pulmonary resuscitation as needed.
- Provide pre-hospital emergency medical care of simple and multiple system trauma such as controlling hemorrhage, treatment of shock, bandaging wounds and immobilization of painful, swollen, deformed extremities.

2. Special Qualifications:

Must have a valid Utah Drivers License Certified by the State of Utah as an Emergency Medical Technician

3. Physical Demands:

- Must be healthy with no medical disabilities that would impair essential functions as an Advanced Emergency Medical Technician
- Must be able to lift and move patients as needed.
- Works in hazardous environments and with potentially violent patients
- Manage physically aggressive inmates as necessary
- This position requires shift rotation

4. Work Environment:

Work is performed in an office or other environmentally controlled room; Works inside a Correctional Facility with potentially violent offenders; Work exposes incumbent to conditions such as fumes, noxious odors, dusts, mists, gases, and poor ventilation; Work exposes incumbent to contagious or infectious diseases or hazardous chemicals; Work requires use of protective devices such as masks, goggles and gloves; Work exposes incumbent to unknown, dangerous, and/or life-threatening conditions; Work exposes incumbent to possible bodily injury from angry inmates, other atypical conditions including subjection to vulgar/offensive verbal threats, and emotional stress from long hours in a negative/dangerous environment
